

FOUR GENERATIONS in Gibraltar!

Hopefully, you've had a chance to meet the Walters sisters — Ann and Cathy — who you may have seen enjoying the beautiful views from their awesome front porch at 220 5th Ave. These ladies are the FOURTH generation to enjoy this grand house!

- > Great Grandparents William & Clara (Phelps) McConnell
- > Grandparents Dr. Gordon & Anna Pearl (McConnell) Best
- > Ann (Jennings) Walters, Senior
- > Ann Walters, Jr. & Cathy Hill

Their great grandfather (William McConnell, a C.B. businessman), purchased the home from the architect, Johannes "John" Jensen, who designed it in 1900 and only lived in it for six months. The McConnell's daughter, Anna Pearl, married Henry Jennings, Jr. Henry's father and mother were Dr. Henry and Hattie Jennings, who lived in the yellow house with white pillars at 201 S. 3rd Street. Henry, Jr. was in WW1 and, from the sound of it, probably suffered from PTSD when he came back home. According to stories, he absconded with the family's money and was hit and killed as he was hitchhiking out of town. By all accounts, the elder Jennings were





supportive of Ann & Cathy's grandmother (now-widowed Anna Pearl) and her children (a son, Henry, III, and daughter, Ann) after the young family moved back in with her parents in the McConnell's house on 5th Ave.

Anna Pearl was married a second time, to Dr. Gordon Best, who then became a step-father to Ann & Cathy's mother, Ann, Sr., and instilled in her a lifelong love of Huskers. They continued to share the house with the McConnells until Ann Sr. moved out and was married. She had three daughters: Ann Jr., Cathy, and Sally. When Ann later divorced, she echoed her mother's actions and moved her young family back to the house on 5th Ave. The young sisters now shared the house with their mother, their grandmother and grandfather, and their great grandmother. FOUR generations under one roof.

In the 20-teens, Ann & Cathy moved back to the house on 5th to be live-in caretakers for their aging mother. Thanks to their care, she was able to live out the remainder of her life in the house she loved so much. The sisters are now hard at work undertaking many household updates and restorations (a full-time job in and of itself when you own an older home). Don't you love history when have an old house in an old neighborhood?

INTERESTING FACTOIDS:

When Ann & Cathy were kids, shortly after their mother divorced they lived for a short time at 135 S. 3rd Street (the Agnus Folsom House now owned by Nate Brown & Tom Emmett!), until their Mom moved back into the family house at 220 5th Ave.

The McConnells (Ann & Cathy's great grandparents) used to play bridge with General and Mrs. Dodge! The Phelps side of the family (Clara's family) came from Illinois, and Clara's father, Stephens, was good friends with Abraham Lincoln. When Ann & Cathy were growing up, it was quite common to have ancient relatives pass through town, and the young girls had to sit at the dining room table and were expected to be seen & not heard, so they sat quietly and just soaked up all the stories. How cool!
